
The Last 6000 Campaign Newsletter November 1, 2019

Knowing the tree species or specific diameter is not required to document a majestic tree. You can just note that it is either Evergreen or Deciduous and that it is 30 inches or larger in diameter at breast height (DBH) per your estimation. While duplication has not been a problem, you can always send an address via email to thelast6000@gmail.com if you are concerned and we will check the database for you.
